The adult selection committee, with the approval of the Scout Executive, will decide who will be candidates for induction provide the following conditions are fulfilled. 1. Selection of the adult is based on the ability to perform the necessary functions to help the Order fulfill it's purposes and is not for recognition of service, including current and prior achievements and positions. 2. The individual will be an asset to the Order because of demonstrated abilities that fulfill the purpose of the Order. 3. The camping requirements set forth for youth members are fulfilled. 4. The adult leader's membership will provide a positive role model for growth and development of the youth members of the lodge.
