Fall Fellowship

Currently the Lodge still plans to hold the only 2020 Fellowship at Camp Illinek on October 16-18! Restrictions based on the most recent Public Health and BSA regulations will be in place. One item includes one tent per person, unless related and within a 2 year range, following all YPT requirements. The cost of the event is \$25, and is only payable at the door the day of the event. The schedule currently includes an Ordeal for incoming candidates, as well as a program for members including a service project in the morning, and fellowship and games in the afternoon. There will also be an opportunity to transition to Brotherhood Saturday morning! Lodge Annual Meeting

Illinek Lodge will hold an in-person Business Meeting for the purpose of members of the Lodge Executive Committee to give our annual reports to the lodge membership. During this meeting, the Lodge Officers' Nominating Committee will present a slate of officer candidates to be voted upon by the youth membership in attendance. The new officers will hold office September 1, 2020 to August 31, 2021.

Typically, this meeting has been held after the Ordeal Ceremony and after dinner at our Summer Fellowship. Since we are not holding our Summer Fellowship, this meeting will take place as a single event. This meeting is scheduled to take place beginning at 7:00 p.m. on Saturday, August 15, 2020 at Camp Illinek. The most current governmental and BSA health requirements will be required.

Application or nomination forms for lodge office can be found on our Lodge website: <u>illineklodge.com</u>. The officer positions include Lodge Chief, Lodge Vice Chief, Lodge Secretary, and Lodge Treasurer. The election of officers will take place in that order. Anyone running for office that is not elected may run for a subsequent office. Arrowmen under the age of 18 must identify approval from parents as well as their Unit Leader. Those wanting to run for office must have their intentions approved by the Nominating Committee, which includes prior personal interviews with the lodge advisers and approval from the Scout Executive, or his designee.

Any youth member of the lodge interested in holding an officer position for the coming season must get in contact with either John Kirchgesner or Matt Torres no later than July 31, 2020.

The National Committee of the Order of the Arrow has announced that **ERIC HARRISON** of Illinek Lodge will be presented with the **DISTINGUISHED SERVICE AWARD**, the highest award presented to a member of the Order on the National level.

Eric is best known in Illinek Lodge for his activation of current lodge members as well as recruiting former members to active duty. He also created and developed new activities within the lodge. Eagle Scout Harrison has served on all lodge committees, and as Lodge Treasurer, Lodge Vice Chief, and Lodge Chief for 2 terms. He went on to become Section Chief, then the National Vice Chief. He lead a lodge team of ceremonialists to the highest level of competition at the 2018 National Order of the Arrow Conference. Eric has

served on Abraham Lincoln Council committees and our Summer Camp Staff, and is currently a Lodge Associate Adviser. He has been recognized previously with the Vigil Honor and the Founders' Award.

Eric would have been presented with the Distinguished Service Award at the 2020 National Conference, if it had not been canceled due to COVID-19. A presentation will be made at a later date.
